Essential Parameters

Core Parameters Every User Should Know

Aspect Ratio (--ar)

- (--ar 1:1) Square (default)
- (--ar 16:9) Widescreen/cinematic
- (--ar 9:16) Portrait/mobile
- (--ar 3:2) Classic photography
- (--ar 4:5) Instagram portrait

Stylize (--s)

- (--s 0-50) Literal interpretation, follows prompt closely
- (--s 100) Default Midjourney styling (balanced)
- (--s 250-500) More artistic interpretation
- (--s 750-1000) Highly stylized, creative liberties

Chaos (--c)

- (--c 0-25) Consistent, similar results
- (--c 50-75) Moderate variation
- (--c 100) Maximum variation, unexpected results

Quality (--q)

- (--q 0.25) Faster, less detailed
- (--q 0.5) Balanced speed/quality
- (--q 1) Default quality
- (--q 2) Higher detail (more expensive)

Classic Art Styles

Renaissance & Baroque

[subject], Renaissance painting style, oil on canvas, dramatic lighting, sfumato technique [subject], Baroque style, dramatic chiaroscuro, ornate details, golden hour lighting

Impressionism & Post-Impressionism

[subject], Impressionist style, loose brushstrokes, dappled sunlight, en plein air [subject], Post-Impressionist style, bold colors, geometric forms, expressive brushwork

Art Nouveau & Art Deco

[subject], Art Nouveau style, flowing organic lines, botanical motifs, elegant curves [subject], Art Deco style, geometric patterns, metallic accents, luxury aesthetic

Modern Masters Style (without naming artists)

Advanced Prompting Techniques

Style Layering

Combine multiple style references for unique results:

[subject], oil painting + digital art hybrid, classical composition with modern colors [subject], photography + illustration blend, realistic base with artistic overlay

Lighting & Mood Control

Lighting Keywords:

- Golden hour, blue hour, dramatic lighting, soft diffused light
- Rim lighting, backlighting, side lighting, studio lighting
- Neon lighting, candlelight, moonlight, harsh shadows

Mood Keywords:

- Cinematic, atmospheric, moody, ethereal, mysterious
- Vibrant, muted, monochromatic, high contrast, low contrast

Texture & Material Specification

Surface Textures:

- Canvas texture, paper texture, wood grain, metal surface
- Glass, marble, fabric, leather, stone, concrete

Artistic Mediums:

- Oil paint, watercolor, acrylic, charcoal, pencil

Camera & Technical Settings

Camera Simulation:

- 35mm film, medium format, large format, instant film

Quick Reference Cheat Sheet

Essential Prompt Structure

[Subject] + [Style] + [Composition] + [Lighting] + [Parameters]

Example:

Portrait of a woman, Renaissance oil painting style, three-quarter view, dramatic chiaroscuro lighting --ar 3:4 --s 250

Common Style Modifiers

- Vintage: aged, retro, nostalgic, faded
- Modern: clean, contemporary, sleek, minimalist
- Dramatic: high contrast, bold, intense, striking
- Soft: gentle, subtle, muted, ethereal
- Bold: vibrant, saturated, dynamic, energetic

Quality Control Tips

- 1. Be specific "Renaissance oil painting" vs. "old painting"
- 2. Layer descriptions combine style + technique + mood
- 3. **Use negative prompts** (--no blurry, distorted, text)
- 4. **Control stylization** adjust (--s) for interpretation level
- 5. **Iterate systematically** change one element at a time

Professional Workflow

- 1. **Start with basic prompt** establish subject and composition
- 2. **Add style references** define the artistic approach
- 3. Refine with parameters control technical aspects
- 4. Iterate and improve systematic refinement process
- 5. Save successful combinations build your style library

Advanced Style Combinations

Hybrid Techniques

[subject], oil painting with digital enhancement, classical + modern [subject], photography with illustration overlay, realistic + artistic [subject], 3D render with painterly effects, technical + organic

Era Fusion

[subject], Victorian era meets cyberpunk, ornate + futuristic [subject], Art Deco with contemporary minimalism, geometric + clean [subject], Renaissance with pop art colors, classical + vibrant

Troubleshooting Common Issues

Style Not Applying Properly

- Increase (--s) value for stronger stylization
- Use more specific style keywords
- Add negative prompts to exclude unwanted elements
- Consider using style references (--sref)

Inconsistent Results

- Lower (--c) (chaos) value for consistency
- Use seed values for reproducible results
- Be more specific in descriptions
- Use style references for reliable aesthetics

Overly Stylized Results

- Decrease --s value
- Add "realistic" or "natural" to prompt
- Use (--style raw) for less interpretation
- Balance artistic terms with descriptive ones
